Memorandum of Agreement in re
Shop & apartments at
11 Thornhill Terrace

of May 1869

Memorandum of an Agreement
made & entered into this twentyfirst day of May
1849. Between James Duffin of No 11
Thornhill Terrace, Islington of the one
part and Frederick Broom of Phoenix
Street of the other part

Whereby the said James Duffin agrees to let
and the said Frederick Broom agrees to take
part of the House No 11 Thornhill Terrace, Islington
afo^rd and in which the said James Duffin now
resides viz: the Shop, Parlour and Front Kitchen
together with the Coal Cellar opposite the Kitchen
Door also the covered area now used by the sd James
Duffin for the purpose of keeping Milk, Butter
&c (reserving to the use of the sd James Duffin
the passage to the Coal Cellar &c) to have and to
hold the sd Shop & Apartments for & during the
term of one year to commence on the twenty first
day of June next after the date hereof at and for
the yearly Rent of twenty eight pounds of good
and lawful money of Great Britain payable quarterly
by even & equal portions, the first quarterly payment
to be due & paid on the 29th of September 1849
and the said Frederick Broom agrees to pay to the sd
James Duffin on the sd 21st day of June next
a proportionate sum at the above rate per ann: to
be computed from the day on which the sd F. Broom
shall take possession of the sd Apartments &c.

And it is further agreed that at the expiration of the
term of one year the sd Frederick Broom may hold
and occupy the Shop & Apartments afo^rd at the yearly
rent of thirty pounds for so long a time as the
said James Duffin and the said Frederick Broom
may & shall agree & upon such terms for the second
year as to notice to quit as may, at the expiration
of the first year, be mutually agreed upon by the
sd J. Duffin & F. Broom Provided also that if the
sd F. Broom shall be desirous at the expiration

of the term first above mentioned to rent & take
the whole House an agree^mnt shall be entered into
upon such terms as ^{shall} ~~may~~ be agreed to by the ^{sd} J. Suffin
& the ^{sd} F. Broom at or for the yearly Rent of Fifty
Pounds.

And it is also hereby agreed by the ^{sd} F. Broom that
he will not carry on or suffer to be carried on upon
the ^{sd} premises any offensive Trade or any
Trade other than what is now carried on by the
^{sd} James Suffin without the consent in writing
of the ^{sd} J. Suffin first had & obtained.
and the ^{sd} Frederick Broom also agrees that when he
quits the said premises he will leave them
in as good condition & repair as they shall be
in on his taking possession thereof reasonable
wear excepted. The following Trades I hereby agree
to allow to be carried on viz^r the Selling of Bread
Confectionary. Fruiterers. Green Grocers and Coals
provided the Coals are not kept in the Shop
