R. N. Civilian Clothing Centre, Cosham, PORTSMOUTH

Officers obtaining their Civilian Clothing outfit from this centre, should arrive before 1600 hours on week days and 1200 hours on Saturdays. The centre is closed on Sundays.

A bus service is in operation between Portsmouth Town station and the Civilian Clothing Centre, this being situated in the Portsdown Garage, Cosham, Portsmouth, just past the round-about at Cosham, and on the main London - Portsmouth Road.

As much notice as possible of your arrival should be communicated to the centre, telephone number Portsmouth, Cosham 76728, or Portsmouth 74571 extension 2154.

Lunch is obtainable in the Ward Room Mess at the Barracks, and arrangements should be made with the Mess Office to pay for the lunch on the spot. (This is very important!)

Cigarette/Tobacco Vouchers covering the period of your leave may be exchanged at the Centre, or at any NAAFI, the main one in the London area being at 140, Long Acre, Leicester Square, W. C. 1.

Cigarette ration is 40 per week, at privileged prices (i. e. 1s. 6d. for twenty). 30 cigarettes are equivalent to 1 oz. of tobacco.
