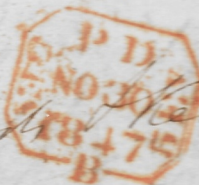

Dear Sir,

By the mail just arrived
I received the enclosed from Mr. Cass Tabor
H. of Calcutta -

In a letter from Mr. J. D. D. of Madras
dated Oct. 13th the following paragraph occurs
"although we have repeatedly advertised the
Lumene & reduced the price to 2/3rd, the
former rate we have not yet been able to
effect additional sales of that article"

The last advice I have from Hong Kong
is enclosed in the following letter from
Mr. Wm. H. D. D. - "In regard to the
Lumene I am afraid the price is rather high
& that you will not be able to sell it at
2/3rd per oz as Dr. Lever & Green at Whampoa
are selling it in retail at 2 dollars 1/2 per oz"

I expect to hear from the other places next month I wish let you know in my next letter" -

From these accounts it would appear that Calcutta is the best market & I have written to Messrs. Hanks & Burton not to sell it under the above price, as if they do not dispose of it advantageously it will be better to send it to Calcutta - I have no doubt but the Madras quantity will be sold -

I regret the transactions have not been so speedy & promptly closed as I expected them -
