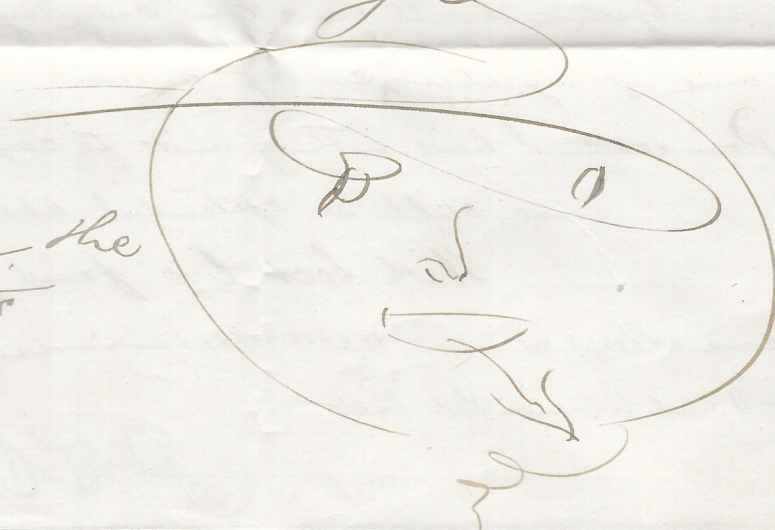

My Dear Floe

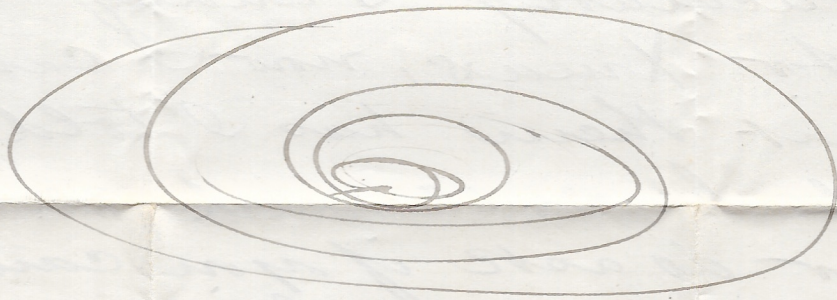
To my surprise
