not eat up quite all the cake

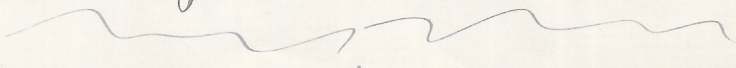
when she helped to cut it up

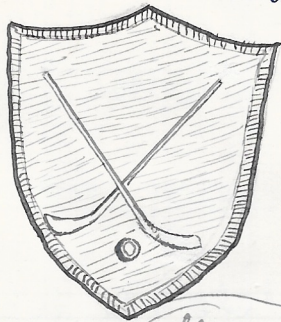
